## BRIEF HISTORY OF BELFAST

The **history of Belfast** as a settlement goes back to the Bronze Age, but its status as a major urban centre dates to the 18th century. According to the city's official history (as seen on a plaque outside St. George's Church), the original settlement was based around the marshy ford where the River Lagan met the River Farset (also called the Belfast River), which today would be where High Street meets Victoria Street. Belfast today is the capital of Northern Ireland. Belfast was, throughout its modern history, a major commercial and industrial centre. It suffered in the late 20th century from a decline in its traditional industries, particularly shipbuilding. In recent years major redevelopment of Belfast city has occurred, especially in the inner-city and dock areas.
