Gosford Forest Park, formerly Gosford Demesne, was acquired by the Department of Agriculture in 1958 and comprises some 240 hectares of diverse woodland and open parkland set in gentle rolling drumlin countryside. It was designated the first conservation forest in Northern Ireland in 1986.

Visitors can also see a selection of Heritage Poultry, Rare Animal Breeds, and Red Deer, but one of the most fascinating aspects of the park is its history and its association with Jonathan Swift.

This venue is within easy reach of Armagh, Newry and Dungannon, all of which provide different outlooks into the culture of Ulster.
